

All examples and punishments are subject to change based on management's decisions. If money is taken, all funds are forfeited.

All forfeited funds will be collected and donated to a family in need or a charitable organization after the race season has ended.

Level 1 - "Verbal"

- *Loss of all money only for the night
- *No time off
- *This would be the lesser of all violations, a 1st warning
 - Examples
 - Getting out of the car for non-safety reason on the track and not listening to the safety crew to confront another person. Drivers that get out of their car on the track must go to the closest safety vehicle
 - Severity being considered, going to confront another driver outside their pits without an official (official being the pit steward or another manager of the track)

Level 2

- *Loss of money & points for the night
- *Keeping it simple, a 2nd warning, more severe violation than Level 1
 - Examples
 - o Repeating the same actions in the Level 1 category after being reprimanded with a Level 1 infraction

Level 3

- *Loss of points & money for the night
- *1 week off on a race night their class is scheduled to race, date T.B.D.
 - Examples
 - Refusing to listen to a safety, security, or other track staff regarding on track or off-track issues
 - o Repeating the same actions in the Level 2 category after being reprimanded with a Level 2 infraction

Level 4

- *Loss of points & money for the night
- *2 weeks off on a race night their class is scheduled to race, dates T.B.D.
- *On probation for the remainder of the season
 - Examples
 - Spinning tires, kicking up gravel, or fish tailing through turns
 - o Repeating the same actions in the Level 3 category after being reprimanded with a Level 3 infraction

Level 5 – "MOST SEVERE VIOLATION"

- *Loss of points & money for night
- *Time off T.B.D. Owosso speedway needs to make decision at Monday night meeting, call said person Tuesday morning with disciplinary action to be carried out.
 - Examples
 - o Getting into a physical altercation with any person
 - Sabotaging another driver's equipment
 - Damaging track equipment
 - o Repeating the same actions in the Level 4 category after being reprimanded with a Level 4 infraction
